

# INTERNATIONAL LAW OF MARINE RESOURCES

Open Elective Module (Wahlmodul) for all CAU students



Participants of the course deepen their understanding of substantive public international law and other means of international ocean governance as a basis for the sustainable management of marine resources. The course offers the opportunity to read, discuss and analyse issues concerning different aspects of the international regulation of the use of marine resources in a seminar-like atmosphere. In contrast to a lecture series, the main focus of the course is to engage into a discourse with all participants on the relevant legal questions.
